- The RV area is available Friday, 9/24/23 at noon through 11am Monday 10/02/23.
- \$500 RV Reservation fee covers Sun. Sept 24, 2023 9am – Sun Oct. 1, 2023 11am checkout only. Additional nights available for extra \$65 per night with paid Sun. – Sun.
- Reservation only. Early check-in begins Friday 9/22/23 at 12 noon, late checkout ends Monday 10/2/23 at 11am.
- Requests for RVs grouped together will be honored if possible, but are not guaranteed.
- 30-amp and LIMITED 50-amp service is available on a first reserved, first served basis. Water tank fill source available with your hose. NOT a water hookup.
- This is a hotel parking area. Founder's Inn Flowering Almond Spa shower and bathroom facilities are available to all paid RV'ers.
- Honey wagon service will be available for a fee.
- All RV spaces must be left in same condition or better than you found it when you depart.
- No open fires are allowed – VA Beach ordinance.
- Ex-Pens may be set up but no anchors, stakes, rods or other devices may be put into the ground or tarmac to hold them.
- All shavings, pellets, etc. must be removed from your area upon departure. Quiet hours 10pm to 6am. Please be considerate of hotel guests and other RV'ers by keeping dogs quiet.
- No refunds will be given after Aug. 1, 2023. Any refunds will be less any fees incurred by SCA 2023.
- Refund requests due to emergency, vehicle breakdown, etc. will be addressed on a case-by-case basis.
- Decision of RV Chair and/or Show Chair are final.

Special Notices

- I. Exhibitors owing money to the SCA for current or past Nationals or for any outstanding debt will have armbands withheld. Upon receipt of cash or money order payment of this debt, armbands will be released.
- II. Refund Policies
 - A. There are no refunds of entry monies for Agility, Conformation events, Futurity, Obedience, Rally, and Sweepstakes except under the provisions of the AKC's refund policy for judge change, change of conditions, etc.
 - B. Refunds may be given for seminars, banquet, RV space, etc., only on a case-by-case basis when SCA does not take a loss due to the cancellation. Normally, when unforeseen circumstances happen, i.e., vehicle breakdown, air cancellations, etc. are sufficient reasons for requests for refunds. The Host Show Treasurer will mail refunds where applicable.

Entry may be made at www.sca2023National.com and must be received by Aug. 1, 2023. Rosettes will not be mailed to entrants that do not attend. A biography of the dog, not more than 100 words, will be read during the presentation of awards if the biography is received by Aug. 1, 2023. Contact Clu Carradine Altasamz1@yahoo.com to confirm your entry and with any questions.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- Show site will be available for exhibitors at 7:00am on Tuesday, September 26th.
- Grooming area will be available at 12:00noon on Sunday, September 24th.
- PROMOTION / DISTRIBUTION OF LITERATURE FOR EVENTS, GOODS OR SERVICES CONFLICTING WITH SCA 2023 SPONSORED EVENTS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
- Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show. Reserved Grooming Tent has limited electrical hookups. Only one dryer per circuit. You may be asked to share.
- Extension cords must be taped down and kept out of walkways.
- Free crating and Grooming will be allowed in designated areas only. You may be asked to stack your crates, and there will be no saving of grooming space and no mats or ex-pens allowed in the designated free grooming area.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to limit the number of grooming tables per handler in the designated free grooming area. NO Electric hookups in the Free Grooming area.
- Cleanup of all grooming areas will be the owner's responsibility, and will be policed daily.
- Dogs must be removed from the Grooming area no later than 11pm each night. All dogs, equipment, and personal items left unattended at any time are at **OWNER'S RISK**.
- Crates with dogs left unattended **AT ANY TIME MUST** be labeled with room number and owner's name and contact information in case of barking dogs and/or medical emergencies.
- The Reserved Grooming Chairperson or Show Chair will resolve all conflicts. Their decisions will be final.
- The number of reserved Grooming spaces is limited. Spaces will be assigned in the order received. No phone or email reservations will be taken. Requests for reserved spaces together must be submitted together, see website on reserved grooming.
- No Smoking in buildings, tents or grooming areas.
- Dogs and equipment must be removed from the Grooming tent by 11pm Saturday, Sept. 30, 2023. Grooming tent will be struck after 12:01am Sunday, Oct. 1, and any property left in tent will be disposed of.
- No crates or X-pens will be allowed at ringside.
- Dogs are **not** permitted in the rest rooms, food or hotel lobby areas, or Rose Garden.
- This is a SELF-CLEANING show. Please make sure to clean up after yourself and your dog in the buildings, tents, on the grounds and hotels, both inside and out. This includes Pee, Poop, dog hair, trash and other refuse of any kind.
- Do NOT let dogs "mark" on buildings, posts, waste cans, in hallways or anywhere except designated "grass exercise" areas.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for maintaining clean conditions around their grooming area and leaving all areas clean at end of each day. Excess hair and other refuse must be swept up and disposed of in refuse containers provided. Exhibitors should have clean-up equipment with them.
- Neither the show-giving Club nor the host site will be responsible for the safety or well-being of dogs or other property left at the site.

- Warm water tubs near grooming tent will be available for dog bathing. 2 Tubs may be reserved for \$5 per 15-minute time slot, at least one tub will be available free of charge on a first come, first served basis. Reserved tubs available at no charge when not in use. Strict 15-minute time limit per dog if others are waiting. Bring your own towels.
- Wet dogs may NOT be brought into hotel. NO BATHING or Grooming of dogs in hotel rooms at any time.
- The show committee has the right to remove or have removed anything found to be blocking or obstructing the aisles. All passageways must be kept open; chairs, grooming and crates are not allowed in walkways. Aisles will be marked for easy access. Aisles, grooming and crating areas will be designated. Extension cords must be taped down to avoid tripping hazard.
- Immediately after loading and unloading vehicles must be moved to the spectator or hotel guest parking area. No parking is allowed immediately adjoining the Grooming tent loading and unloading area. Vehicles left unattended in unloading area for excessive length of time will be removed at owner's expense.
- Exercise pens – are allowed ONLY in Reserved Grooming or RV area and must have plastic, matting or other protective material under. If shavings are used, they must be kept contained and from blowing into other areas. For safety, NO dogs may be left unattended in ex-pens at any time.
- No tent stakes, signs, or other items may be stuck in the ground, parking lot or any other areas, as this could damage underground wiring.
- Reserved seating lottery will be available Tuesday – Saturday. A limited number of “saved” ringside and “End of the Diagonal” seats will be drawn each afternoon for the following day beginning Monday at Novice Weight Pull. Each registered attendee will receive a free ticket for each day at Registration. Additional tickets may be purchased daily. Winners will be posted outside the Ballroom. All personal chairs ringside must be removed at the end of each day's judging and may not be brought back ringside more than 30 minutes before the designated start of judging each day.
- For safety reasons, strollers are strongly discouraged at this show. Sole liability will be accepted by the user of the apparatus and absolves the SCA and the show giving committee of any liabilities.
- All Regulations governing the use of this facility and all regulations and decisions of the Show Committee will be strictly enforced, including any not recorded in this Premium List.
- Trophies not awarded or claimed at the show at which they are won become the property of the show giving Club. The Clubs reserve the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value if any prize listed or described becomes unavailable. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - none will be mailed.
- All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.
- A recording Fee of 50 cents and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. These Fees are to be collected by the show giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2) THIS IS INCLUDED IN THE ENTRY FEE PAID.

- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs allowed in rings during judging only. There will be NO practicing in rings at any time.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging.
- Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**
- **RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check & credit card. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.
- The show giving Club, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.
- Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram to the Superintendent prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.
- Refunds of \$3.00 and less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.
- An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

- Have an SCA Working title (WS, WSX or WSXM), an AKC Tracking title, or an AKC Performance Event Title that required at least three qualifying scores. (Included but not limited to obedience, rally, agility, herding, etc.).
- Any other AKC certifications, tests and titles based on pass/fail scores do not qualify (example CGC, HIT, THD).
- Documentation of qualifications for entry must accompany entries. Champions of Record that have working titles are also eligible.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dogs and two to four of their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. The Get **MUST** be entered and shown in one of the Regular Classes at this show. The Stud Dog is the **ONLY** dog to be listed on the entry form and must be shown in the ring with his Get. Awards will be based on the merits of the Get. The Stud Dog and Get shall be considered as one entry for determining entry fees for this class. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular or additional conformation, obedience, or agility classes, or in Best of Breed competition, if eligible, in which case Stud Dog shall be considered a second class of the same dog requiring an entry fee of \$28.00. If entered only in Stud Dog Class, the fee shall be the regular entry fee of \$28.00. No Stud Dog or his Get may be shown as part of another unit.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as above except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog, Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS - The Brace Class shall be for two dogs of at least one identical owner or co-owner regardless of sex. The two dogs comprising the Brace shall be considered a unit and they must be named at time of entry. If a dog, which is to be part of a brace is not entered in a regular class, or Best of Breed Competition, the dog must be entered for "Brace Class Only." In making entries for Brace Class Only, full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a brace, **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for **ADDITIONAL CLASSES** – "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising **EACH** brace must be designated, "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. Please submit Brace entries together.

TEAM CLASS – Same as for Brace Class, except it will be for four dogs of the same breed, with at least one identical owner or co-owner.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes. Ch. 11, Sec 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

MERIT AWARD

At the discretion of the judge, a Merit Award Plaque, offered by the Samoyed Club of America, Inc. may be given up to 10% (always rounded downward) of all those competing for Best of Breed. The 10% figure shall be based on the total Best of Breed entry at the time of closing, i.e., disregarding absentees or transfers from the classes, plus two for Winners Dog and Winners Bitch, plus an additional number for each winner of the following classes: All 3 Veteran Dog Classes, all 3 Veteran Bitch Classes, Working Dog, and Working Bitch. All those in Best of Breed competition shall be eligible to receive a Merit Award, except the Best of Breed Winner, the Best of Opposite Sex Winner, the Grand Champion Select Dog, and the Grand Champion Select Bitch.

SCA FUTURITY CLASSIFICATION

Eligible puppies for this Futurity will include those born on or after **April 5, 2022 and up to and including March 26, 2023**. Per futurity rules Individual puppies from a nominated litter are eligible to compete in the first annual futurity held on or after the date the puppies reach 6 months of age, and **ONLY** in this stake. Therefore, the class is 15 months and over.

DIVISION OF ENTRY MONEY AS PRIZES

The division of stakes will be made between the breeder, owner, and the owner of the sire, with the following proportions: the breeder is to receive 50% of the stake, the owner is to receive 35%, and the owner of the sire is to receive 15%.

The expenses of the Futurity will be deducted up to a maximum of 35% from the Futurity Stake, the remainder of the stake will be awarded to the winning Samoyed in the following proportions: The Grand Futurity Winner will receive 20% of the stake, the Best Futurity Puppy (6 – 12 months) and the Best Futurity Junior (12 months and over) will each receive 10%, the winner of the Intersex judging of each age division will receive 10%, and the Reserve Winner 5%.

SCA FUTURITY ELIGIBILITY

Nominations to the Futurity are open only to breeders who are active members in good standing of the Samoyed Club of America, Inc. The bitch whose litter is nominated must be owned, co-owned, or leased by a Samoyed Club of America, Inc member. This requirement does NOT apply to the owner(s) of any eligible puppies, nor to the owner(s) of the sire.

To be eligible to compete in the Futurity, a Samoyed must meet the following requirements:

- Be from a litter which was properly and timely nominated
- Have been individually nominated before it reached the age of four months
- Be properly entered in one of the regular classes at the National Specialty or Obedience Trial
- Not be bred, or ever owned, co-owned, or leased by this year's judge, or member of his immediate family, nor sired by or out of a Samoyed ever owned, co-owned, or leased by this year's judge or member of his or her immediate family.

(Eligible puppies for this Futurity will include those born on or after April 5, 2022 and up to and including **March 26, 2023**).

FUTURITY JUDGING PROCEDURE

Each age division will be divided by sex. The judge will judge males first, then females of each age division in order, and will make four placements for each sex. The judge will then select an Intersex Winner and Reserve Winner for that age division. (These can be the same sex.)

When the first two age divisions have been judged, the winner of the 6 – 9 Months Division will compete against the winner of the 9 – 12 Months Division for the title of the BEST FUTURITY PUPPY.

After the third and fourth age divisions have been judged, the winner of the 12 – 15 Months and the 15 Months & Over division will compete for the title of BEST FUTURITY JUNIOR.

The Best Futurity Puppy will then compete with the Best Futurity Junior for the title of GRAND FUTURITY WINNER.
